Dear Mighty Mite, Initiation, Novice, Atom Parent:

Yes, it is time to think about hockey registration again!! We would like to welcome you to the start of the registration process for the 2010/11 season with Southland Hockey Association (SHA).

This letter is being sent to inform you of the registration process for the 2010/11 hockey season.

Our Annual General Meeting will take place on May 30th, 2010 at the Oakridge Community Center. Fee prices will be announced, as well as elections for available SHA board positions will take place at this meeting. Your attendance and participation would be valuable to your child's hockey experience.

If you are considering running for a board position, please send an email to president@southlandhockey.com and put your name forward along with the position you would like to be considered for. Please see the SHA website for a detailed listing of which positions will potentially be available for election.

SHA will have 2 forms of registration:

- **Online registration** – credit card payment only. Open to both players & coaches.
- **Walk in registration** – see below for detailed information

Online registration will be available starting the day after our annual AGM. The only form of payment will be credit card. This will be open to all age categories, as well as coaches and will ensure registration of your child & consideration for coaching with SHA.

To be considered as a coach for the 2010/11 season, you must also register online through the Hockey Canada Registration system. A coach application form will also need to be completed. Potential Coaches that are not registered by July 31st may not be considered for a coaching position within SHA. Those wishing to register after this date must contact the Development Coordinator.

Please ensure you read instructions carefully while proceeding with the Online Registration, and that you are inputting correct information such as date of birth, telephone numbers and email addresses. Should you encounter any problems with the Online Registration, please email registrars@southlandhockey.com and completely describe the problem you are having. Please note that the Hockey Canada Registration system will only work on current versions of web browsers (IE 7 or higher, etc.).

SHA Player Registration deadline is July 31st, 2010 in order to provide enough time to compile registered player lists and determine ice requirements for the evaluation process. Please ensure that you are registering your child prior to this date to guarantee that they are a part of this process.

REGISTRATIONS AUGUST 1ST OR LATER:

Registrations that occur August 1st or later, will be subject to a fee increase of \$100.00 per player & MUST be handled through the Registrar of SHA, based on program availability. Should there be room in the appropriate age category for your child an email will be sent to you with the online registration link. **Manual registrations will NOT be accepted.**

If any of the following scenarios apply to you, you MUST attend the walk in registration session. If these situations do not apply to you, you MUST register online with payment by credit card.

There will only be **1 walk in registration session** to be held on June 5th, 2010 at the Oakridge Community Center. Please note that cash or credit cards (credit cards accepted for those with registration credits only) will not be accepted at the walk in registration. **Manual registrations will NOT be accepted after this date for any reason.**

1. **You have registration credits** from various events, such as the Hockey Calgary Casino, community bingos, etc. Unused credits cannot be carried over to another season.
2. **You need to pay by cheque or money order.**
3. **You need to apply for the Calgary Flames Even Strength Program.** Please note the application for the FESP can be found on the Hockey Calgary website at www.hockeycalgary.com under the forms section.

Please print off a copy of this application, and bring the necessary paperwork with you to the walk in registration session to be held June 5, 2010.

Please note that the age category your child will be registered in for the upcoming season is based on their age as of DECEMBER 31st of each registration year. For example, a child born in 2006 would still be registered for the Mighty Mites program as they are only 4 years old as of December 31, 2010.

We hope this clears up any confusion for you regarding the registration process for the 2010/11 season with Southland Hockey.
